Transition: What Should Happen When

By age 14

Transition services begin by age 14 in Virginia

Identify the student's goals, likes and interests through formal and informal assessments Identify supports the student may need in the future, such as residential supports,or vocational rehabilitation

If not on community waiver waitlist, get on NOW.

By age 17

Adult service providers will begin attending transition meetings by this age, if not sooner

Community work experiences and course work will be provided

Determine decision making supports needed, including guardianship, power of attorney, representative payee, etc.

Begin applying for SSI

By age 18 or before leaving school

Have all identification paperwork, such as ID, Social Security cards

Finalize employment, day supports, and educational goals prior to leaving school
